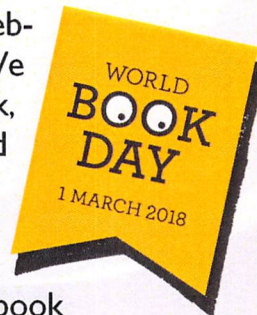
OPA Sporting Competitions
