Restorative Practice

In school, we encourage the children to use restorative practice to help resolve conflict. The children take on the responsibility of discussing what has happened, taking into account how everyone in the situation feels and then looks to solving the issue. We have restorative practice leaders in school who help promote this. It has proven an effective way of dealing with issues.
